

## DREAMSCHEME AGREEMENT

### for Registered Dreamscheme Groups

## THE PROCESS

A local group may become a Registered Dreamscheme when it has fulfilled the following criteria:

- ADOPTED the method of working with young people (WORK, POINTS and TRIPS)
- TRAINING: at least one key person in the group to have attended Dreamscheme Level 2 Training
- PAID: £50.00 annual membership fee (2003 prices)
- AGREED to abide by the Dreamscheme Agreement
- APPLICATION FORMS submitted to the Dreamscheme Network
- VISIT: each group must have been visited by a Dreamscheme Network representative

Registration will be completed when Dreamscheme Network Trustees have agreed the application at the next Dreamscheme Network Trustees meeting.

### **Notes**

Termination of membership will be formally minuted at the Dreamscheme Network Trustees meeting.

Membership will enable groups to buy Dreamscheme products and services at reduced rates and will give access to advice and support from Dreamscheme staff.

Subscriptions are valid for 1 year from the first day of the following month in which they were paid.

## **REGISTERED LOCAL GROUPS**

### **We agree:**

1. to abide by the rules governing the use of the name, trademarks and intellectual property surrounding the Dreamscheme Network, the logo and associated designs
2. to support the aims and objectives of the Dreamscheme Network
3. to pay the membership fee of £50.00 per group per annum (2003 prices)
4. to complete annual returns
5. to involve young people only over the age of 8 for legal and insurance reasons

### **We are responsible for:**

1. behaviour and actions of volunteers and young people
2. raising of funds, spending, accounting, etc.
3. policies & procedures<sup>1</sup>
4. insurance for the group

### **We will not:**

1. raise monies under the Dreamscheme Network charitable status number
2. sell or copy any Dreamscheme Network products or training materials

## **THE DREAMSCHEME NETWORK**

### **We will:**

1. Give notice of the Annual General Meeting to all members at least 30 days in advance
2. Offer advice and support to all members via telephone. Individual or on-site consultation is available; costings are available through negotiation with the Dreamscheme Network
3. Co-ordinate training and conference activities
4. Develop products and services
5. Distribute a newsletter free of charge twice a year
6. Give notice of any changes to the constitution, structure, pricing policies etc.

**The Board of Trustees reserves the right to impose termination of membership at any time if it is felt that the group is not abiding by the Agreement of the Network.**

Successful groups are often asked to give presentations to other groups or organisations. It is acceptable to display your work and achievements and celebrate your success. It is really good for the young people to be involved in this.

Groups are asked to:

- 1) inform the Network of these presentations,
- 2) always include information and material about The Dreamscheme Network
- 3) forward all training requirements and enquiries to The Dreamscheme Network.

Groups may not sell the intellectual property of The Dreamscheme Network - to write and sell a training manual, deliver training or present the original concept as their own. This would result in termination of membership. This clause is included because the Dreamscheme Network strives to maintain and control the quality of Dreamscheme replication and implementation of the Dreamscheme Method on behalf of all its members.
